Trial synopsis	This study is for people who have silicosis and are scheduled to undergo a whole lung lavage (WLL) as part of their care. As you will know from discussion with your treating doctor silicosis is a scarring condition of the lungs caused by inhaling silica dust and is difficult to treat. The research project is aiming to understand the effectiveness of whole lung lavage (WLL) as a treatment option for silicosis.
